HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

The father of the petitioner was working as Lineman in the office of XEN, Operation Division P.S.E.B, Nabha. He unfortunately died on 01.07.1990 while in service. The petitioner is the only son of his deceased father and at the time of his death, petitioner was aged about 1 year only. On attaining the age of 18 years, the petitioner represented to the respondents on 10.10.2007 to give him appointment on compassionate basis and also annexed the certificates of his educational qualifications as required by the Board. It is the case of the petitioner that despite his repeated representations to the respondents, he has only received oral assurances that his case is being processed, but nothing in writing has been communicated to him so far.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that at this stage, he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to the respondents to take a decision on the representation dated 10.10.2007 (Annexure P-2) wherein, he has raised his claim for compassionate appointment.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to consider and decide the representation/application dated 10.10.2007 (Annexure P-2) expeditiously, preferably within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
