By way of the instant writ petition, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks direction to the respondents to grant emoluments of the higher post of Assistant Controller against which the petitioner has discharged his duties and payment of interest on the delayed payment of pension.

The learned counsel contends that for the redressal of his grievance, the petitioner has moved representations, Annexure P-7 and Annexure P-9, however, the same have not been decided so far.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, to consider and decide the representation, Annexure P-9, in terms of order Annexure P-8, by passing a speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
