The grievance in this writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for transfer of the registration and allotment of dwelling unit No.1238, Sector 43-B, Chandigarh in favour of the petitioner being sole surviving legal heir of her allottee-husband Sh. Surinder Singh Paul.

Learned counsel for the respondent has produced communication dated 23.04.2015 addressed to the petitioner wherein it has been stated as under:-

*“Dwelling Unit No.1238, Sector 43-B, Category
HIG, Chandigarh was allotted on hire-purchase basis to
Sh. Surinder Singh Paul s/o Late Sh. Gurdial Singh Paul
vide allotment letter No.968 dated 23.08.1989.*

*Consequent upon the death of the said allottee
Sh. Surinder Paul on 17.05.2001, the registration and*

allotment of the said dwelling unit is hereby transferred in your name i.e. Smt. Santosh Paul w/o Late Sh.Surinder Singh Paul on the original terms and conditions as mentioned in the allotment letter on the basis of Intestate Demise.”

The communication is taken on record.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the respondent that in view thereof, the petition has been rendered infructuous and may be disposed of.
