During the course of arguments, it has gone uncontroverted that services of the petitioner were regularized on the post of Mali-cum-Chowkidar in the year 2003. The claim set up in the instant writ petition is with regard to regularization on a Class-III post instead i.e. Water Pump Operator, Grade-II/Assistant Pump Operator.

In so far as the initial order passed in the year 2003 regularizing the petitioner was on a Class-IV post i.e. Mali-cum-Chowkidar, no challenge to the same has been raised.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the instant writ petition with liberty to file a petition afresh to raise a challenge to the order passed in the year 2003, whereby benefit of regularization had been granted to the petitioner not on a Class-III post but on a Class-IV post.

Prayer is allowed.

Petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty, as prayed for.

However, it is clarified that the liberty granted to the petitioner to file a petition afresh would not be construed towards this Court having condoned the delay that has occurred while raising such a challenge.

Disposed of.
