RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK, J. (Oral)

Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioner has approached this Court by way of instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari/mandamus.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, fairly states that he does not intend to press this writ petition for a writ in the nature of certiorari, for the time being. He further submits that the petitioner will be satisfied in case respondent No.2 is directed to adjust the petitioner on any post of ANM/Multi Purpose Health Worker (Female) available throughout the State of Haryana, preferably in any of the District adjoining to District Jind under the National Health Mission Scheme.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, Director, National Health Mission, Tourism Bhawan, Panchkula-respondent No.2. is directed to look into the matter and consider the grievance of the petitioner, which prima facie seems to be

genuine and reasonable, thereby adjusting her on any available post of ANM/Multi Purpose Health Worker (Female) under the National Health Mission Scheme. Petitioner shall also be at liberty to move an appropriate representation before respondent No.2 within a period of two weeks from today. Respondent No.2 is further directed to make an endeavour to adjust the petitioner against any available post of ANM/Multi Purpose Health Worker (Female) in any of the District adjoining to District Jind at an early date and preferably within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

With the observations made above, the present writ petition stands disposed of.
