RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK, J. (Oral)

Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioners have approached this Court by way of instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus.

Learned counsel for the petitioners, at the very outset, fairly states that although petitioners are seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus, yet they could not submit a comprehensive representation on behalf of all the petitioners because of bonafide wrong impression. He further submits that given an opportunity, petitioners shall approach the competent authority, i.e. respondent Nos. 2 to 5 by moving a comprehensive justice demand notice on behalf of all the petitioners within a period of three weeks from today and respondents No. 2 to 5 may be directed to consider and decide the same, within a reasonable time.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, respondents No. 2 to 5 are directed that if the petitioners approach them by their respective justice demand notices within a

period of three weeks from today, the same shall be considered and decided at an early date, by passing appropriate orders thereon, strictly in accordance with law, but in any case within a period of three months from the date of receipt of representations from the petitioners.

With the above-said observations made and directions issued, the present writ petition stands disposed of.
