SURYA KANT, J. (ORAL)

1.) The precise question raised in this writ petition is that though the dependents of Ex-Servicemen are eligible to compete in Haryana Civil Services (Judicial Branch) for the posts reserved for Ex-Serviceman category to the extent of non-availability of suitable Ex-Serviceman but such candidates, after they have appeared in the main written examination, are not being considered against the posts of open or their other respective categories even if their marks in the main written examination are more than the last candidate of such

categories.

2.) Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since the Government instructions on this issue are silent, he may be permitted to withdraw the writ petition, with liberty to approach and seek clarification from the State Government.

3.) We accept the request. The representation, if any, made by the petitioner in this regard shall be considered by the Competent Authority in the State Government and appropriate decision shall be taken within a period of four months from the date of receipt of such representation.
