The petitioner prays for issuance of a writ of mandamus directing respondents No.2 and 3 to pass an order regarding refund in accordance with the claim made by the petitioner in form VAT-29 referred to in detail in Annexures P-2, P-3 and P-4, respectively.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that refund is to be recommended by respondent No.2 and thereafter has to be sanctioned by respondent No.3 as per Rule 52(6) of the Punjab Value Added Tax Rules, 2005. The petitioner has submitted the requisite form but despite repeated reminders, no further action has been taken.

We have heard counsel for the petitioner, perused the paper book and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the controversy, dispose of the writ petition by directing respondents No.2 and 3 to consider and decide the petitioner's claim for refund within two months from receipt of a certified copy of this order.
