Challenge in the present writ petition is to the order dated 30.01.2015 (Annexure P6) whereby the benefit of extension of one year of service, has been cut short on account of two chargesheets dated 29.10.2013 (Annexure P7) and 28.11.2013 (Annexure P8) issued under Rule 8 of the Punjab Civil Services (Punishment & Appeals) Rules, 1970. The petitioner's extension period is to expire on 31.08.2015, i.e., 3 days from today.

In such circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. The petitioner shall, however, be entitled to continue till 31.08.2015. The interim protection was only granted on 29.04.2015. Thus the petitioner will not be entitled for any financial benefit from 01.02.2015 till 30.04.2015, as he was never protected by any order of Court. However, he will be allowed to continue till 31.08.2015 and entitled to all benefits, as per the terms of extension. It is clarified that all the interim orders, passed in the present writ petition are hereby vacated.
