By way of instant writ petition, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks release of her pensionary benefits along with interest 18% p.a.

The learned counsel contends that for the redressal of her grievance, the petitioner has served legal notice dated 02.04.2014 (Annexure P-3), however, the same has not been decided so far.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, which is stated to be respondent No. 2, to decide the legal notice, Annexure P-3, in the light of law laid down in **Gujjar Singh and others** Vs. **PRTC and others**, 2005(4) SCT 67 DB, by passing a speaking order, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
