AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

The grievance raised in this writ petition is that the petitioner was rejected for consideration for the post of Head Constable on the ground that his height was less than 170 cm whereas as per the certificate issued by the government Hospital Annexure P-3 his height is 173 cm. Learned counsel prays that a direction be issued to respondent No.5 to remeasure the height of the petitioner because as per him there was some error when his height was being measured at the time of selection.

Keeping in view the fact that a Govt. Hospital has certified the height of the petitioner to be more than that required, in my considered opinion it would be in the interest of justice if respondent No.5 once again measures the height of the petitioner. It is, however, made clear that this second measurement would be binding and learned counsel for the petitioner has very fairly undertaken that the petitioner would not challenge the second measurement.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.
