AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has approached this Court with a grievance that the result of the petitioner is not being declared for appointment to the post of Clerk as his certificates/degrees have not yet been verified. Counsel contends that result of some of the candidates who have obtained the degrees from Punjab and Haryana, has already been declared. Petitioner has, therefore, served a legal notice dated 24.12.2014 (Annexure P-8) upon the respondent which till date has not been decided and the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to the respondent to decide the legal notice within some specified time.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner, without going into merits of the case and commenting thereon, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent to consider and decide the legal notice dated 24.12.2014 (Annexure P-8) within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.

Copy of this order be given dasti to the counsel for the parties under signatures of the Special Secretary of this Court.
