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DEEPAK SIBAL, J. :

It is inter alia argued by learned counsel for the petitioner that he could not have been transferred from Gurgaon to Ambala because he fell under the Clause IV of the circular of the Insurance Company dated 05.06.2014 annexed as Annexure P-3 with the writ petition, since he had done business for more than Rupees one Crore and thus, was exempted from the Transfer Mobility Policy (TMP). In this regard, the petitioner had also approached the respondent - Insurance Company through a

representation dated 28.07.2014. Learned counsel states that this representation has not been decided till date and at this stage, he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the respondent to decide this representation within a time bound frame.

I consider this prayer made on behalf of the petitioner to be reasonable. Accordingly, I direct the respondent to decide the representation made by the petitioner within one week from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to say that in case, the decision so rendered by the respondent, on the representation made by the petitioner, is unfavourable to the petitioner, he would be at liberty to challenge the same in accordance with law.

Meanwhile, the interim protection granted in favour of the petitioner by the Delhi High Court through its order dated 10.02.2015, is ordered to be extended till the decision on the representation as per the directions given above, is served on the petitioner.

A copy of the order be given to the counsel for the petitioner under the signatures of Bench Secretary.
