RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK, J. (Oral)

Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioner has approached this Court by way of instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari/mandamus.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not intend to press this writ petition for the writ in the nature of certiorari, for the time being. He further submits that given an opportunity, petitioner shall approach the competent authority, i.e. respondent No.2 by moving an appropriate representation within a period of four weeks from today and respondent No.2 may be directed to consider and decide the same, within a reasonable time.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, including the issue of limitation, if any, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, Incharge, Army Recruitment Zone Ambala-respondent No.2, is directed that if the petitioner approaches him by moving an appropriate representation

within a period of four weeks from today, he shall consider and decide the same at an early date, by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly in accordance with law, but in any case within a period of two months from the date of receipt of representation from the petitioner.

With the above-said observations made and directions issued, the present writ petition stands disposed of.
