The petitioners pray for issuance of a writ of mandamus to restrain the Gram Panchayat, Village Rai, and Kamla Devi, Sarpanch, Gram Panchayat, Village Rai, from excavating a drain through the manure pits allotted to the petitioners at the time of consolidation.

After addressing arguments for some time, counsel for the petitioners prays that as he has filed a representation to the Director General, Panchayati Raj, Haryana, Chandigarh, the writ petition may be disposed of at this stage by directing the said officer to look into the matter and decide the representation in accordance with law.

We have heard counsel for the petitioners, perused the paper book and in view of the limited nature of the prayer, dispose of the writ petition by directing the Director General, Panchayati Raj, Haryana

(respondent No.2), to appraise the representation/petition (Annexure P-5) and after issuing notice to the Gram Panchayat, examine the matter in its entirety and pass an appropriate order under Section 47 of the Haryana Panchayati Raj Act, 1994.
