AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

It is the contention of counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner at this stage would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Sub Divisional Magistrate, Nabha, to consider and decide the representation/request dated 10.04.2012 (Annexure P-3) as moved by her for sanction of mutation under the Hindu Succession Act within some specified time, especially when vide communication dated 18.06.2014 (Annexure P-5), the Deputy Commissioner, Patiala, has directed the Sub Divisional Magistrate, Nabha, to take appropriate steps for disposal of the representation of the petitioner.

Keeping in view the above submissions made by counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Sub Divisional Magistrate, Nabha-respondent No.3 to consider and decide the

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representation dated 10.04.2012 (Annexure P-3) within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.
