AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL) .

Petitioner has approached this Court with a grievance that respondent No.5 and its members are obstructing and restraining the petitioner from carrying out its business of transportation, loading and unloading of the material from the trucks hired. Counsel for the petitioner has placed reliance upon the judgment passed by this Court in **CWP No.18143 of 2006** titled as **Manjinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab and others**, decided on 04.10.2008 (Annexure P-5) to contend that the action of the respondent No.5 and its members is not sustainable. Highlighting this aspect, petitioner has submitted a representation dated 19.02.2015 (Annexure P-3) to respondents 3 and 4 but no action thereon has been taken till date.

Counsel, therefore, contends that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if direction be issued to respondents 3 and 4 to look into the representation and take appropriate steps in accordance with law.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondents 3 and 4 to look into the matter and consider the

representation dated 19.02.2015 (Annexure P-3) submitted, at an early date, preferably within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.
