AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

It is the contention of the counsel for the petitioners that the RCC pipeline existing in the land of the petitioners, which was installed about 15 years back, is in dilapidated condition and is frequently leaking from different places. Despite repair being done for that, the situation has not improved. Repeated requests made to the respondents has not yielded any result and the remedy, therefore, is for either replacing the same or to instal new underground pipeline as is being done in various parts of State of Haryana. Counsel for the petitioners prays for liberty to file a detailed representation to respondents 2 and 3, highlighting therein the grievances, which the petitioners are facing and the loss, which they have to suffer because of the leakage of water in the fields.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file a detailed representation to respondents 2 and 3 within a period of four weeks from today. If such a representation is made, the same shall be considered and the decision taken thereon within a period

of three months from the date of submission of such representation.

Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioners forthwith.
