By way of instant writ petition, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks release of monthly pension, P.F., leave encashment, dearness allowance and other retiral benefits along with interest @ 12% p.a.

The learned counsel contends that for the redressal of her grievance, the petitioner has moved representations, Annexure P-1 & P-2, however, the same have not been decided so far.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, to consider and decide the representation, Annexure P-2, by passing a speaking order, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
