A writ in the nature of certiorari is prayed for, quashing the order dated nil, passed by respondent no.2, (Annexure P-10), vide which the candidature of the petitioner has been rejected, being ineligible for consideration to the post of Staff Nurse in the sports category.

An analysis of the order (Annexure P-10), reveals that as per the Punjab Sports-person Recruitment Rules, 1988, for appointment to the Class-III post, the minimum sports achievement that is required at the State level is, 1st, 2nd and 3rd position (Grade-'C'). However, the achievement of the petitioner was graded as 'D'. Further, merit list of the candidates in the sports category (female) was drawn in terms of the provisions of para 6 of the 1988 Rules, and the Gradation Policy 1997, prepared by the Sports Department.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the paper book.

Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute that the rules referred to above, do postulate that for appointment to a Class-III post, a candidate must possess a “Grade-C”, certificate at the State level. Concededly, the sports grading of the petitioner is 'D'. And this is not the case of the petitioner that grading of her achievement is either erroneous or wrong.

That being so, the grievance being made by the petitioner is wholly misconceived.

The petition being devoid of merits is dismissed in limine.
