AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

By this petition the petitioner has challenged the order dated 14.09.2010. The husband of the petitioner, who was an employee of the Sugar Mill, Panipat, died during the service on 28.02.2010 and she had moved an application for compassionate appointment. By the impugned order it was decided that since as per rules only 5% posts could be earmarked for compassionate appointment and, since that quota had already been consumed, the alternate relief of granting Rs. 5 lacs as ex gratia compensation was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel has argued that the petitioner was a handicapped person and she should have been given a job. However, the fact remains that this writ petition has been filed after more than 4 ½ years and there is no explanation for the delay and latches.

In the circumstances the petition is dismissed.
