ARUN PALLI, J.(ORAL):-

A writ in the nature of mandamus is prayed for, directing the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner for appointment as Vocational Mistress (Computer Science), against the seats reserved for candidates belonging to SC (R & O) category, as still three such posts are lying vacant, in terms of the decision rendered by this Court in ***State of Haryana vs. Gajraj Singh, 2011 (4) SCT 207.***

It is maintained that prior to the institution of this petition, the petitioner had represented to respondent No.2, vide representation dated 29.04.2013 (Annexure P-4), but the same has failed to evoke any response. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that, at this stage, let this petition be disposed of, with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation made by the petitioner within a stipulated period of time.

That being so, and, without expressing any opinion on

merits, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2, to consider and decide the claim of the petitioner, as set out in the representation dated 29.04.2013 (Annexure P4), in accordance with law, within a period of three months, from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Needless to assert, a comprehensive order shall be passed assigning reasons, in support of the decision arrived at.

The petition stands disposed of.
