This Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to the respondents to pay interest to the petitioner on the amount of arrears which have been allowed to the petitioner vide order dated 11.06.2009 (Annexure P-7).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he will be satisfied if the respondents are directed to consider and decide the case of the petitioner in the light of judgment titled as **Charan Singh VS. State of Punjab and others**, passed in CWP No.12432 of 2004, decided on 11.07.2006. He further submits that similar relief has been granted to the co-employee i.e. Roshan Singh vide judgment dated

12.05.2014 (Annexure P-6).

In view of above, without adverting to the merits of the case, at this stage, respondents are directed to consider and decide the case of the petitioner in terms of Charan Singh's case (supra) within eight weeks from the receipt of certified copy of this order.
