By way of the instant writ petition, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks direction to the respondents to count the services w.e.f. 22.08.1987 to 08.01.1990, rendered by the petitioner in the Government Aided school and to grant service benefits including increment and pensionary benefits etc., along with arrears.

The learned counsel contends that for the redressal of his grievance, the petitioner has served legal notice dated 01.12.2013 (Annexure P-7), however, the same has not been decided so far.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, to decide the legal notice, Annexure P-7, in the light of law laid down in **Sukhdev Singh and others** Vs. **State of Punjab and others**, rendered in CWP No. 14238 of 1991 (Annexure P-4) and in CWP No. 4578 of 2010 titled as **Durlabh Singh and others** Vs. **State of Punjab and others**, (Annexure P-5) by passing a speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
