AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

The petitioner filed an appeal against her termination which has not been decided so far. Thereafter she filed CWP No. 17798 of 2014 but by order dated 22.09.2014 the same was dismissed as premature in view of the pendency of the appeal. The prayer in the present petition is that despite the lapse of more than one year the appeal has not been decided and a prayer is made for a direction to the appellate authority-respondent No.3 to decide the appeal on merits within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request.

Resultantly it is directed that the appeal Annexure P-7 filed by the petitioner be decided within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order on merits by giving reasons.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.
