By way of the instant writ petition, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks direction to the respondents to count the entire adhoc/daily wage service rendered with the respondents and for grant of retiral benefits to the petitioner.

The learned counsel contends that for the redressal of her grievance, the petitioner has moved various representations and served legal notice dated 16.12.2014 (Annexure P-7), however, the same have not been decided so far.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, to consider and decide the legal notice, Annexure P-7, in terms of order passed in CWP No. 14973 of 1989 dated 13.07.2004 (Annexure P-3), by passing a speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
