AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Counsel for the petitioner does not press the present writ petition on merits, although he had tried to persuade that the undertaking, which was given by the petitioner during the proceedings before the Tribunal was not with a free will. He, however, states that since it is a matter between the family, there is every possibility of an amicable solution to the differences, which have arisen. He states that the petitioner, at this stage would be satisfied if the matter is referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court for amicable resolution of the differences between the parties.

In view of the above statement of the counsel for the petitioner, on instructions from the petitioner, who is present in Court, the matter is referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

Let respondents 4 and 5 be summoned for 23.03.2015.

Dasti only.

Status quo with regard to the house in question shall be

maintained till the matter is pending before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre which shall be concluded by 27-4-2015.

The present writ petition stands disposed of in the light of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner and the above observations, in case the Mediation and Conciliation succeeds, the matter be put up before this Court on 30-4-2015.
