By way of the instant writ petition, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks direction to the respondents to count the period of service rendered by the petitioner on adhoc basis w.e.f. 20.11.1984 to 01.01.1991 for the purpose of pensionary benefits.

The learned counsel contends that for the redressal of his grievance, the petitioner has moved representation dated 27.01.2014 (Annexure P-6), however, the same has not been decided so far. He further states that he will be satisfied in case the same be decided by the competent authority in terms of the order passed by this Court in CWP No. 15081 of 2011 titled as **Shanno Devi Vs. State of Haryana and others.** (Annexure P-7).

Keeping in view the statement made, without advertng to

the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, which is stated to be respondent No.3, to decide the representation, Annexure P-6, in terms of Shanno Devi's case (supra), by passing a speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
