ARUN PALLI, J.(ORAL):-

Contentends that on 23.05.2013, this Court had passed the following order:

“Counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present writ petition with liberty to pursue his representation pending with the respondents.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.”

It is submitted that post passing of the aforesaid order, petitioner served a legal notice dated 30.07.2013(Annexure P14) upon the respondents, but the same has failed to evoke any response.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that, at this stage, let this petition be disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 30.07.2013 (Annexure P14) served by the petitioner, within a stipulated period of time as the same is pending consideration for quite some time.

That being so, and, without expressing any opinion on merits, and the period that has elapsed, all this while, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2, to consider and decide the claim of the petitioner as set out in the legal notice dated 30.07.2013(Annexure P14), strictly, in accordance with law, within a period of four months, from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Needless to assert, a comprehensive order shall be passed assigning reasons, in support of the decision arrived at.

The petition stands disposed of.
