1. Whether Reporters of local papers may be allowed to see the judgment?

AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed by two petitioners challenging their respective transfer orders. In this connection the petitioners are stated to have moved a representation Annexure P-6 to respondent No.2 but no action has been taken thereon as yet. Learned counsel states that petitioners would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the said representation by passing a speaking order thereon within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request.

Resultantly this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation Annexure P-6 of the petitioners by passing a speaking order thereon within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
