The petitioner, who is a Graduate in Veterinary Sciences, has filed the instant petition seeking quashing of the decisions dated 24.09.2014 (Annexure P-3) and 27.10.2014 (Annexure P-7) taken by the Veterinary Council of India (respondent No.2 herein), whereby permission has been granted to respondents No.3 and 4 to admit the students in Private Veterinary College in the coming session of 2014-15.

It is the case of the petitioner that the institutions, to whom the aforesaid permission has been granted, are not having proper and sufficient infrastructure and faculty, therefore, the permission should not have been granted to them, as it will effect the standard of education. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in this regard, a representation dated

07.01.2015 (Annexure P-10) was made by the petitioner to respondent No.2, highlighting the short-comings and shortage of the infrastructure as well as faculty in the institutions, to whom the aforesaid permission has been granted. However, no decision has been taken on the said representation. In these facts, learned counsel prays that at this stage, this petition may be disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the aforesaid representation and take a decision thereon in accordance with law.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, without issuing notice of motion as it will un-necessary delay the matter, we dispose of this petition with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the representation dated 07.01.2015 (Annexure P-10) made by the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order, expeditiously.
