Petitioner has challenged the order whereby the State Information Commission has held as follows:

“(i) The document fee of Rs.1632/- sought by the Social Welfare Department shall be deposited by the then BD&PO, Shri Rakesh Sandhu and the SPIO-cum-Sarpanch by distributing it equally, within a week.

(ii) The Social Welfare Department will immediately provide the information as per their available records within 4 fours.

(iii) The penal proceedings against the respondents are dropped with a warning to the then BD&PO and the SPIO-cum-Sarpanch to be more careful and cautious while dealing with the RTI applications hence forthwith.”

The main contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that admittedly the information was not in the custody of the petitioner and, therefore, this order could not have been passed.
