The petitioner seeks an order directing the respondents to issue a no objection certificate entitling him to transfer the plot in favour of the 3rd party. The respondents had insisted upon an affidavit annexed as Annexure P-2.

In a group of writ petitions one of which is *CWP No.4878 of 2014 titled as Ankur Kapoor v. Haryana Development Authority and another*, decided on 21.11.2014, we took on record a policy dated 11.08.2015 announced by Chief Administrator, HUDA. The modifications thereto are also recorded in a separate order and judgment passed today.

In these circumstances, the writ petition is disposed of by directing the respondents to process the petitioner's application in accordance with the said policy within a period of eight weeks from today.
