SURYA KANT, J. [ORAL]

Since the petitioners' claim regarding sale of Gram Panchayat land in their favour is based upon the Gram Panchayat resolution dated 20.06.2011, which is said to have been passed when petitioner No. 2 herself was Sarpanch of the Gram Panchayat, we are satisfied that it was a case of conflict of interest and no resolution could have been passed for transfer of the Gram Panchayat land in favour of the petitioners. The other reason which dissuades us from issuing any direction is that as per the material brought on record, the petitioners already own immovable property in the village. No case, thus, to issue the desired directions is made out.

Dismissed.
