AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

It is the contention of counsel for the petitioner that in compliance with the order passed by this Court in Civil Writ Petition No.24496 of 2011 (Haryana State Auctioneers Association Vs. State of Haryana and others) decided on 02.08.2014 (Annexure P-10), the petitioner-Association has served legal notices dated 04.10.2011 (Annexures P-11 to P-16) to respondent Nos.3 and 5 to 9. He, however, contends that no response thereto has been received by the petitioner-Association till date.

Counsel contends that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent Nos.3 and 5 to 9 to consider and decide the legal notices dated 04.10.2011 (Annexures P-11 to P-16) filed by the petitioner, within some specified time.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner and without going into the merit of the case or commenting thereon, the present writ petition is disposed of with directions to respondent Nos.3 and 5 to 9 to consider and decide the legal notices dated 04.10.2011 (Annexures P-11 to P-16) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.

In case the claim of the petitioner is accepted, the consequential benefits, if any, be released to it, in accordance with law, within a further period of forty five days.
