The matter came up for hearing on 16.03.2015 and none caused representation on behalf of the petitioner. The matter was deferred for 10.07.2015. The present CM has been filed for preponment of the hearing in the main petition. Keeping in view the averments mentioned in the application, the same is allowed. The hearing of the main petition is preponed for today.

By way of the instant writ petition, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks directions

to the respondents to calculate the entire service rendered by the petitioner and grant the benefit to the extent of 66 half yearly instead of 65 half yearly along with interest @ 18% per annum.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has served legal notice (Annexure P-1) for the redressal of his grievance. He states that he will be satisfied in case the authorities are directed to decide the legal notice within a stipulated period.

Having regard to the nature of relief sought, this Court deems it appropriate to direct the respondent No.2 to treat the present petition as a representation and decide the same within a period of four months from the receipt of certified copy of the order, by passing a reasoned and speaking order.
