Counsel for the petitioner states that although the telephone and telegraph connection has been disconnected as per the order passed by this Court but the equipment/apparatus/appliances of the respondent No.2 are still lying on the roof of the petitioner and the same is not being removed. Counsel has served a legal notice upon the the Estate Officer, Bharti Airtel Limited-respondent No.2, as also the Secretary, Chandigarh Housing Board, Chandigarh, dated 05.01.2015 (Annexure P-8), which till date has not been considered and decided, as no response has been received. He states that the petitioner at this stage would be satisfied if direction is issued to respondents 2 and 3 to consider and decide the legal notice within some specified time.

Without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present writ petition is disposed of with directions to respondents 2 and 3, to consider and decide the legal notice dated 05.01.2015 (Annexure P-8), within a period of six weeks from the date of

receipt of certified copy of this order. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.
