In case, such a representation is moved, then the competent authority shall consider and decide the same in view of the ratio of law laid down in **The Financial Commissioner and Principal Secretary to Govt. of Haryana, Irrigation Department, Civil Secretariat, Chandigarh** Vs. **Hasan Singh Kanwar**, 2010(1) SLR 788 and **A.J. Randhawa** Vs. **State of Punjab**, 1998(1) SCT 343, within a period of eight weeks after the receipt of such a representation.
