AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

In the present writ petition, the only limited prayer of the petitioner is for issuance of a direction to the Divisional Commissioner, Jalandhar-respondent No.3 to pronounce the order in MA Nos.2, 3, 4 and 5 of 2014 in which arguments were heard and order reserved on 30.07.2014.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that earlier the claim of the petitioner was accepted vide order dated 28.10.2010 (Annexure P-4) passed by the Divisional Commissioner, Patiala, against which respondent No.4 filed review petitions on 16.12.2010 (Annexure P-5). The matter since then is pending and ultimately was heard and order served on 30.07.2014 by respondent No.3. More than six months have passed now but till date, the orders have not been pronounced. He contends that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Divisional

Commissioner, Jalandhar-respondent No.3 to finally pronounce the orders at an early date.

In view of the statement made by counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Divisional Commissioner, Jalandhar-respondent No.3 to pronounce the order reserved on 30.07.2014 in MA Nos.2, 3, 4 and 5 of 2014 at an early date, preferably within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
