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As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellants, learned counsel and representatives of the Insurance Company, separately recorded, a sum of ₹2,50,000/- (₹ Two Lacs Fifty Thousand Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants in full and final settlement of the claim. Two months' time is allowed to the Insurance Company to deposit the amount before the MACT, failing which, interest at the rate of 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. As suggested by learned counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount would be paid to appellant No.1 – Balbir Singh, by the Insurance Company/Motor Accident Claims Tribunal. The appellant No.1 – Balbir Singh, may furnish bank account particulars with IFS Code to the Insurance Company/MACT.

The appeal is disposed of accordingly.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
