AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

It is the contention of counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners are working as Guest Faculty Lecturers in Rajindera College, Bathinda. They apprehend their replacement by another set of contractual employees, which, the counsel contends, is not permissible in law. He states that petitioners, at this stage, would be satisfied if the writ petition is disposed of as in the case of **CWP No.3922 of 2013 titled as Balwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and others**, decided on 21.02.2013 (Annexure P-2).

In the light of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioners, the present writ petition is disposed of in same terms as in Balwinder Singh's case (supra).
