Writ in the nature of certiorari is prayed for to quash the order dated 12.01.2015 (Annexure P5), passed by respondent No.3, vide which the petitioner has been dismissed from service.

Having argued the matter at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner very fairly states that there does exist a statutory remedy by way of an appeal under the rules against the order of dismissal and, therefore, he be permitted to withdraw this petition so as to enable the petitioner to file an appeal before the competent authority in the first instance. Further, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as the petitioner shall file an appeal within a period of two weeks from today, the authorities be directed that in case any such appeal is filed, the same be decided within a specified time.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

Though needless to assert, in the event any such appeal is indeed filed by the petitioner against the order of his dismissal, the same shall be decided, strictly in accordance with the law, within a period of three months from the date of filing of the said appeal.
