Learned counsel for the appellants as well as learned counsel for respondents No. 1 to 8 have stated that the parties have effected compromise, under which the amount of compensation has been received by respondents No. 1 to 8, who were applicants before the Commissioner under the Workmen's Compensation Act, Circle Sirsa (in short 'the Commissioner'). Therefore, their claim has been satisfied. It has been further requested that some other amount was ordered to be deposited before the Commissioner and the respondents/applicants before the Commissioner have no objection, if the same is refunded to the present appellants.

In view of the matter, the present appeal is disposed of in terms of the compromise.

The amount now lying deposited before the Commissioner is ordered to be refunded to the appellants as the claim of the respondents/applicants has been satisfied.
