By way of the present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks action against respondent Nos.3 and 4, stating them to be encroachers upon the Panchayat land/public passage.

The learned counsel contends that for the redressal of her grievance, the petitioner has moved representation, Annexure P-10, however, the same has not been decided so far.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, which is stated to be respondent No.2, to consider and decide the representation, Annexure P-10, by passing a speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
