This civil writ petition has been filed under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of directions to the respondents to release the retiral benefits along with interest @24% per annum, count the service of the petitioner from 19.09.1975 rendered with respondent No.3, permit the petitioner to deposit the CPF fund from the date of his initial appointment for taking into account the aforesaid service for the retiral benefits.

Learned State counsel refers to letter dated 13.02.2015 of the petitioner addressed to the District Education Officer, Gurgaon wherein he admits the factum of receipt of Rs.3,12,816/-

towards gratuity and Rs.1,78,108/- towards arrears. He further states that no balance amount is left.

This letter is taken on record as Mark 'A'.

In these circumstances, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
