The petitioner seeks counting of service rendered by her in the Privately Managed Government Aided School, for calculating the pensionary benefits including pension. The learned counsel cites *Sukhdev Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab*, rendered in CWP No.14238-1991, decided on 10.03.2010.

The learned counsel contends that for the redressal of his grievance, the petitioner has served a legal notice, Annexure P-4, however, the same has not been decided so far.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to decide the legal notice, Annexure P-4, in the light of Sukhdev Singh's case (supra), by passing a speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
