ARUN PALLI, J.(ORAL):-

A writ in the nature of mandamus is prayed for, to direct the respondents to pass a formal order declaring that the petitioner has successfully completed the period of probation. And also to release annual increments, that were not released owing to the pendency of the writ petition i.e. CWP No. 13148 of 2002, filed by the petitioner, assailing her termination from the post of JBT Teacher, and, now since, the same has been allowed vide order dated 18.11.2014 (Annexure P7). And to this moment, no appeal has been preferred against the said decision.

Further respondents be directed to grant additional increments on completion of 4/9 years of service under the Assured Career Progression Scheme dated 03.11.2006 (Annexure P8).

It is maintained that post decision of this Court i.e.18.11.2014 (Annexure P7), the petitioner had even served upon the respondents, a legal notice dated 24.12.2014 (Annexure P12), but the same has not been heeded to.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that, at this stage, let this petition be disposed of with a direction to the respondents, to consider and decide the legal notice dated 24.12.2014 (Annexure P12), within a stipulated period of time.

That being so, and without expressing any opinion on merits, the instant petition is disposed of, with a direction to the respondents, to consider and decide the claim of the petitioner as set out in the legal notice dated 24.12.2014 (Annexure P12), strictly, in accordance with law, preferably, within a period of four months, from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order. Needless to assert, a comprehensive order shall be passed assigning reasons, in support of the decision arrived at.

The petition stands disposed of.
