AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present writ petition with liberty to file a detailed representation to the Additional Director General of Police, Security, Punjab, Chandigarh-respondent No.3, highlighting therein the threat perception. He further states that no reason for withdrawing the security already provided to him has been communicated and all of a sudden the same has been withdrawn. He states that the said representation will be filed within a period of one week from today, which may be directed to be considered and decided at an early date.

Without considering or commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file a representation within one week to the Additional Director General of Police, Security, Punjab, Chandigarh-respondent No.3. If such a

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representation is filed within the time stipulated, the same shall be considered and decided by respondent No.3 by passing a speaking order within a period of six weeks from the date of submission of the representation. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner.
