Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the order dated 09.02.2015 (Annexure P-15) passed by respondent No.1 whereby appeal filed by the petitioner has been adjourned for three months for awaiting the decision of learned Civil Court which has no bearing on the legality of the order impugned in the appeal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that appeal was

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filed on 28.08.2014. The matter was heard and reserved, however, the same was released. No order has been passed and even no date has been given for addressing arguments.

Keeping in view the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case and without commenting upon merits, this Court deems it fit and appropriate to direct respondent No.1 to decide the appeal positively before 24.12.2015. Ordered accordingly. Parties through their counsel are directed to appear before respondent No.1 on 16.12.2015.
