Instant writ petition has been filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents, especially respondent No. 2, to take appropriate action as per law on the representation-cum-legal notice dated 9.07.2013.

In pursuance of the order dated 29.04.2015 passed by this Court, the petitioner has sought information under RTI from the office of Commissioner, Faridkot Division vide letter dated 5.06.2015 and placed the same on record as Annexure P-15. It has been specifically communicated to the petitioner vide Annexure P-15 that after receiving the reply from the Naib Tehsildar, CDC and after perusing the same, the case has been filed by the Commissioner vide its order dated 8.01.2015.
